

Light bulbs



Is to contain

- ✓ Energy-saving light bulbs and other light sources containing mercury.
- ✓ Fluorescent lamps that are not linear tubes.

Is not to contain

- ✓ Fluorescent lamps, linear tubes.
- ✓ Is not to be in packaging.
- ✓ E-waste, incandescent lamps, hazardous waste and other types of waste.

Description

Used and new light sources containing mercury, such as energy-saving light bulbs.

Collection

Separate collection units, such as receptacles. Important that this is amassed so as it does not break.

Processing

Delivered to approved waste reception facility for processing and/or destruction.

Recycling

Hazardous waste is to be taken out of circulation and is not to be recycled. If possible, the metal is recycled.

Non-compliance

Hazardous waste is to be taken out of circulation and is not to be recycled. If the waste is shattered, the waste reception facility may refuse to accept it. The declaration must be completed for the driver to take hazardous waste.
